



## PUBLIC HOLIDAY DATA ENTRY

With 2002 coming to a close, it is the time of year to enter the public holidays for 2003 into TRANSPAC, if you have permanent jobs set up in your system.

It is necessary to enter the public holidays so that those permanent runs are not created on the days when public holidays fall.

If you do not enter these dates then TRANSPAC will create the permanent runs and these will be on your despatch screen awaiting allocation the day after the Public Holiday.

To enter the following dates into your TRANSPAC System go to the 'Permanent Jobs' menu, and select the 'Public Holiday Maintenance' option, or, at any menu, type in: holiday <enter>
