

Techo Tip #8



DATE AND TIME MAINTENANCE

There may be times when you need to change your system date or time, for example at daylight saving changeover or when your system clock is slightly out.

TO MODIFY THE SYSTEM DATE OR TIME

- * Log on to the system as the 'root' user (you will need the root password for this).
- * At the '#' prompt type:
date<space>**month number-day number-hour of day-minutes**
year<enter>
- * For example, if the date is the 31st of October 1999 and the time is 5:45pm then you would type in:
date 1031174599 <enter>
- * Make sure you use the 24-hour clock timekeeping method.
- * To confirm the date and time you have entered is correct, at the '#' prompt type:
date <enter>

This will display the date and time you have just entered.
